- 2018-2019 – 65% of Americans call themselves Christian
- 2009 – 77% of Americans call themselves Christian
- 2018-2019 - 26% are non-religious or marked “none” in regards to religion
- 2009 – 17% marked “none” in regards to religion

Foundations for a Christian Worldview

- Absolute moral truths exist
- Such truth is found in the Bible
- God being the all-powerful and all-knowing Creator of the universe, which He stills rules today
- The Bible being accurate in what it says;
- Jesus Christ lived a sinless life
- Salvation is a gift from God that cannot be earned



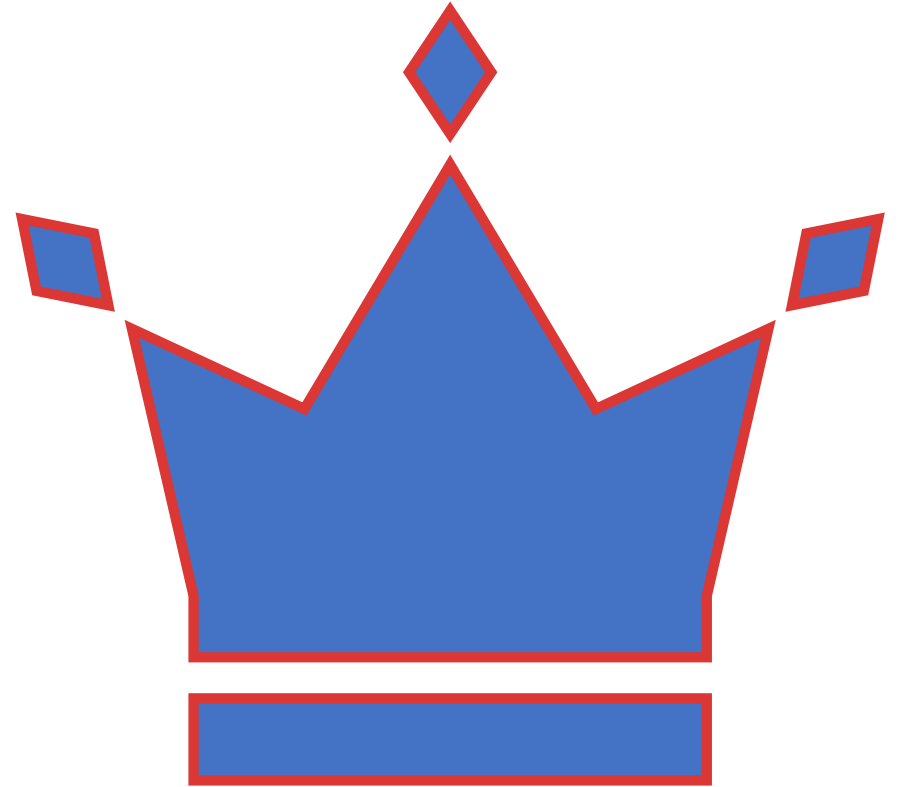
