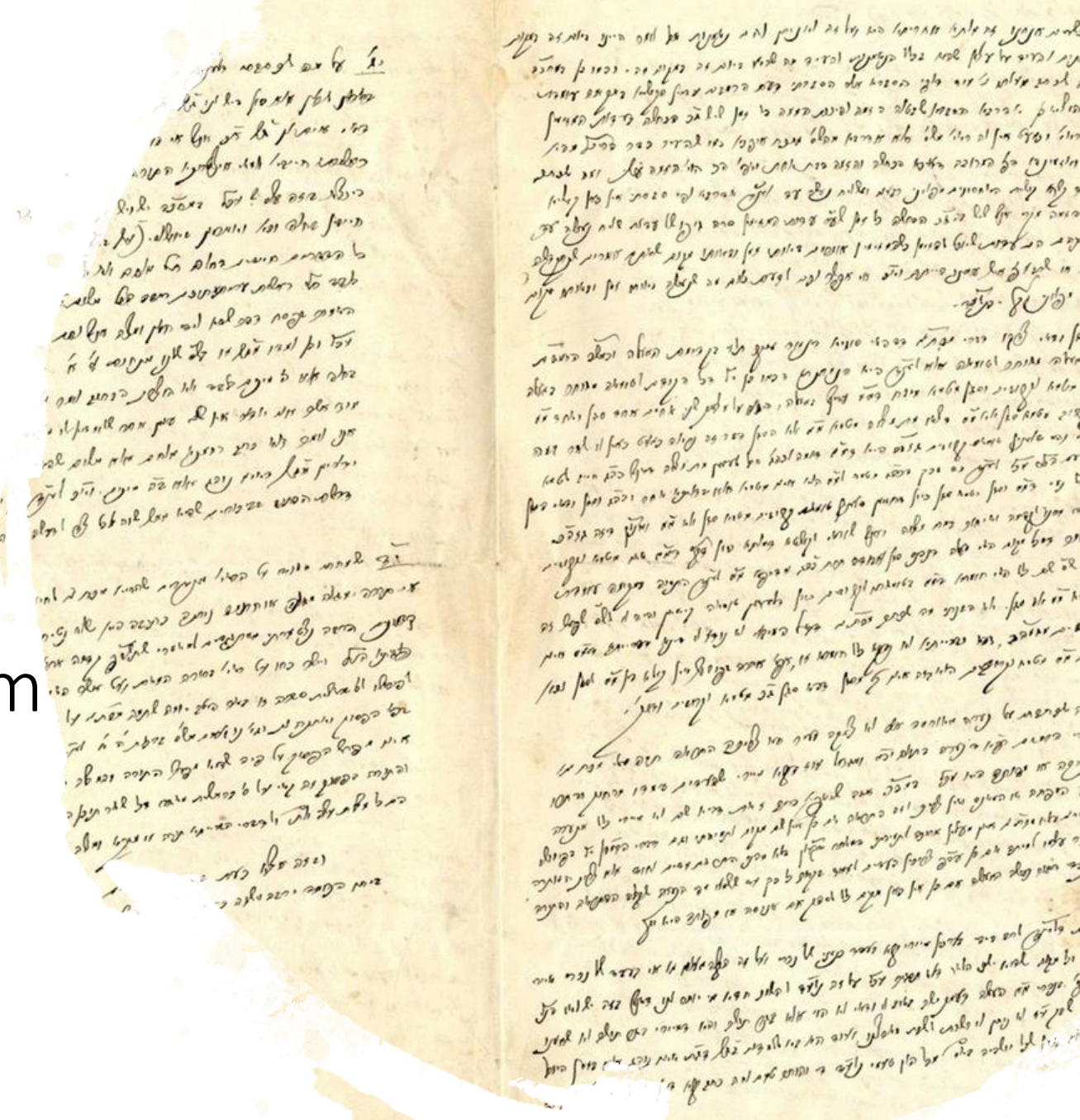

Awareness About Our Present Circumstance

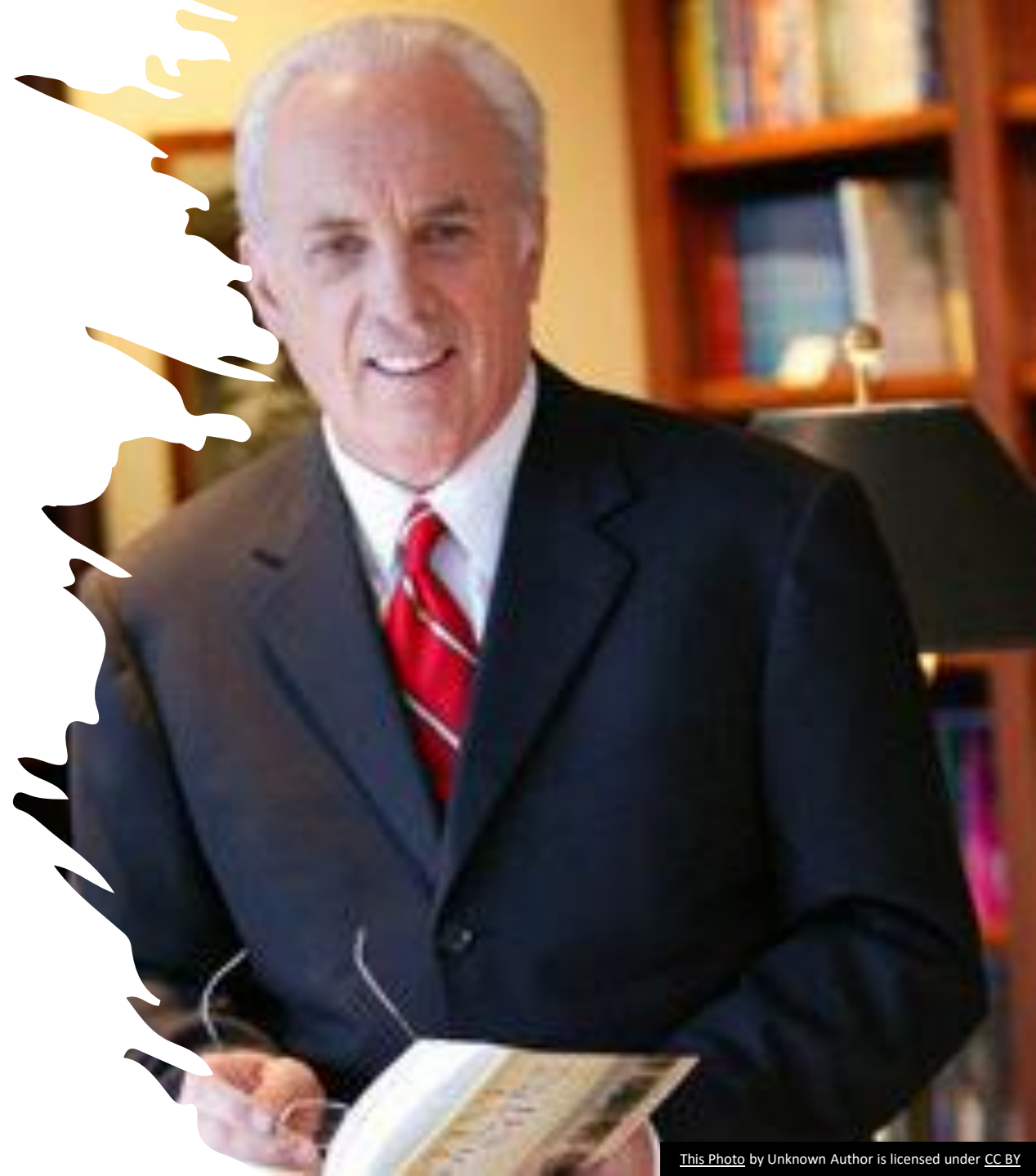
1 Corinthians 10:6-11

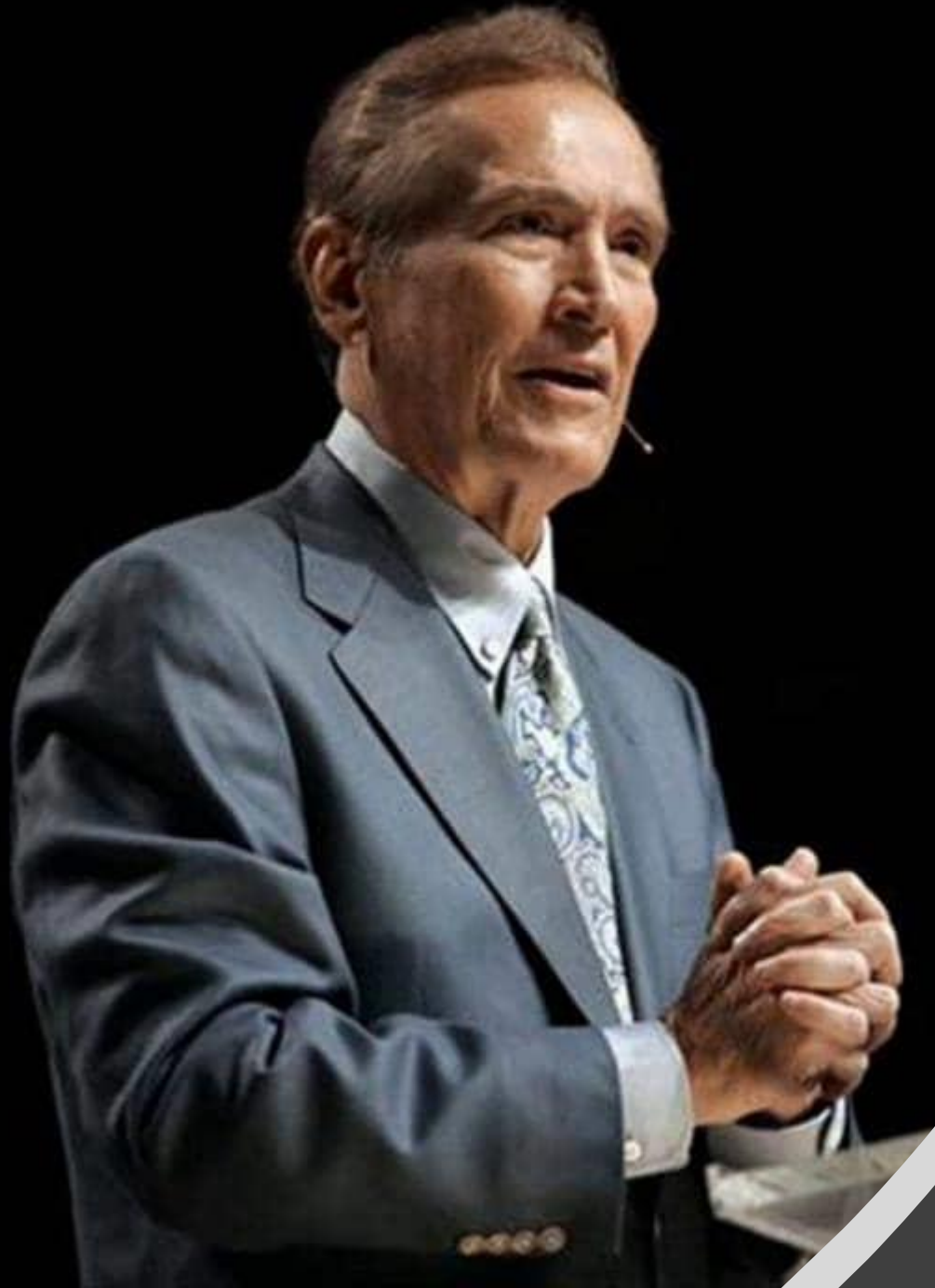


Awareness About Our Future
