#### **Certification and Governance**

Christian Women's Job Corps is a national program of the Women's Missionary Union, a self-governing and self-supporting auxiliary of the Southern Baptist Convention, dedicated to the cause of missions. WMU trains site coordinators and annually certifies each site. The Shoals site was founded in 2016, and is now a certified site.

Governed by an Advisory Council who are members of the community, CWJC of the Shoals is self-supporting, and umbrellas through Woodmont Baptist Church. Gifts and contributions are tax deductible.

## WHO WE ARE

Christian Women's Job Corp of the Shoals is a faithbased program that combines practical training, emotional healing, relationship-building, and spiritual growth opportunities in classroom studies and follow-up one-on-one guidance.

Offering two sessions of 12 weeks each year, CWJC classes are held on Tuesday, Wednesday, and

Thursday, 8:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. at Woodmont Baptist Church (East Campus) on Darby Drive. Sessions begin in January and August.

FREE. The program is free with free lunch and free child care for children of participants.

# WHAT WE TEACH

- Basic job search skills such as: job applications, interviews, job shadowing, what employers expect, and work ethic.
- Personal budgeting
- Money management
- Computer basics
- Relationship-building and parenting
- Health, anger and forgiveness
- Community resources that are available for women
  in need
- Core considerations for making wise decisions
- Setting boundaries, breaking strongholds
- Bible studies with emphasis on God's grace and sufficiency for our needs.
- Grounding in a Christian worldview of life and it's struggles;
- and more.

### **OPERATIONS**

- Volunteer Staff Site Coordinator: Margaret Roland Nursery workers: 1 to 2 volunteers take care of the children of participants
- Instructors number about 10 per session and are volunteers. Mentors are also volunteers- Christian women who provide guidance and friendship one-on-one for a year after the classroom instruction ends.
- Mentors meet one on one with participants for 6 months to a year.
- Lunch is provided by volunteers who bring a meal for the women and their children.
- Classes are held at Woodmont Baptist Church (East Campus) serving all of the Shoals area.
- Two semesters of classes are offered each year, coinciding with the public school's calendar. CWJC is not in session in the summer and over Christmas holiday. Classes are on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday from 8:30 a.m.~1:30 p.m. Participants are expected to attend all classes
- Application and Interview are needed for consideration and acceptance
